OBIECTIVE

STRATEGIES

A Mental Health Focus

Providing healthy snacks, breakfast and lunch programs, indoor and outdoor P.E. and extra-curricular activities that support student and teacher well-being.

B. Indigenous Focus

Culturally responsive teaching and learning that supports the *Truth and Reconciliation Calls to Action*.

C. PATHWAYS FOCUS

Enhance **student awareness** and **understanding** of, and access to, the various pathways.

GOAL: PROVIDE INFORMED, PERSONALIZED, AND TARGETED INSTRUCTION BALANCING INQUIRY, USE OF TECHNOLOGY, AND REPEATED PRACTICE AND USE OF SKILLS TO BUILD MATHEMATICAL FLUENCY.

STRATEGIES

A. **Bridge the gap** through teacher **collaboration** and implement **high-impact instructional** practices through **spiral instruction** and assessment.

B. Support educators in implementing differentiated instruction focusing on mathematical fluency, problem-solving, and communication of student learning.

C. Support all educators in making math authentic and engaging, to improve student mindset towards mathematics.

GOAL: PROVIDE INFORMED, PERSONALIZED, AND TARGET INSTRUCTION TO ENHANCE STUDENT LITERACY LEARNING AND ACHIEVEMENT ACROSS THE CURRICULUM, K-12. (BALANCED INSTRUCTION/ASSESSMENT)

Strategies

A. Teachers regularly monitor and review student progress and provide **specific descriptive feedback** that informs planning and instruction and that includes student voice.

B. Support all educators in implementing a **balanced reading and writing program** using a variety of strategies and resources.

C. Provide **engaging and authentic** reading and writing opportunities.

MONITORING/ACTION PLAN

- Strength Based Mindset/Growth Mindset Focus
- Monitoring Progress in Destreamed Classes and Transition to treamed.

Impact: School Climate Survey 2021 (see data appendix)

Approximately $\frac{2}{3}$ of students had not been physically bullied (64%), about half of students had not been verbally bullied (54%), of students had not been socially bullied (63%), and most had not been cyber bullied (79%) in the past 4 weeks.

- Credit Accumulation for grade 9-10's: 100%
